If you do not feel comfortable or someone is getting too close to you or if there is an incident with another participant, please report this to us (at the main room on zoom, via WhatsApp at 0041 61 260 22 88 or at young@mission-21.org). You can turn off sound and video anytime.

Not everyone likes their pictures or screenshots of their engagement to be taken. We understand and appreciate your wish to do so, for example to share your excitement about the event with others. However, if you want to take pictures or screenshots, we ask you to make sure everyone whose picture, video, name or alike is visible is comfortable with this and agrees to you taking a picture or a screenshot.
